PARENT/STUDENT BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES

Rights and Expectations:

We believe students have the right to a quality outdoor experience. We believe, we have the right to instruct students without being unduly interrupted because of poor student behavior. We further believe participating in Camp Gilmont Outdoor School is a privilege, not a right.

Guidelines:

1. Students should be attentive and actively participate.
2. Students should respect the rights of others and their property.
3. Fighting will not be tolerated.

Consequences and Procedures:

- The student is given a verbal warning.
- The student is reminded and sent to time out.
- The student is reminded and sent to an extended time out.
- The student will lose the right to participate in an activity.
- The student will be sent to their home campus.

Fighting and Stealing are automatic causes for return of the student to their home campus at their parents expense.
